Fieldwork Dates

11th-17th November 2015

Data Collection Method

The fieldwork was conducted online. Invitations to participate were sent to members of online panels. Non-response from different demographic groups was taken into account during the fieldwork phase and post-fieldwork adjustments.

Sample

All residents aged 18+ in United Kingdom. The sample size is 1,528 respondents.

Weighting

Results were weighted to reflect the profile of all UK adults aged 18 and above. Targets were Age/Sex, Government Office Region (GOR), Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) and past vote. All targets are based on Official Statistics from the ONS that are awarded National Statistics status, and the results of the 2015 General Election.

Margin of Error

As a sample of the population was interviewed, the results are subject to a margin of error around various estimates. This means that, given the random nature of the sampling process, we can be confident that the actual result lies somewhere within the margin of error. For example, where 50% of a given population (the worst case scenario) responded in a particular way, with a sample of 1,500 we can be 95% certain that the actual value will fall 2.5% either side of the result. However, where 90% of a given population responded in a particular way, with a sample of 1,500 we can be 95% certain that the actual value will fall 1.5% of the estimate. Users should note that subsamples within cross-breaks will be subject to a higher margin of error, so any conclusions drawn should be treated with caution.

Questions & Presentation

All results are shown in full below, in order, and using the wording that was put to respondents. For questions where the list of responses is names of parties, names or statements, these will typically have been displayed to respondents in a random order, but be ordered in the attached tables. Questions typically not shown in a random order are those where there is a natural or accepted order to maintain i.e. a scale from “strongly agree” to “strongly disagree”, a list of numbers from 0 to 10, or questions that have a factual, rather than opinion-related answer, such as key demographic information. Responses such as “Other”, “Don't know” and “Refused” are not usually randomised.

Tables Before & After Paris Terror Attacks

As fieldwork was conducted both before and after the terror attacks in Paris on 13th November 2015, in order to comparatively assess any 'shift' in opinion, a series of tables based on a split sample of those who participated before 2020GMT (2120CET), and those who participated after, have been computed. These results have been weighted to reflect the profile of all UK adults aged 18 and above. Targets were Age/Sex, Government Office Region (GOR), Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) and past vote. All targets are based on Official Statistics from the ONS that are awarded National Statistics status, and the results of the 2015 General Election.

Pre-Paris Attacks Tables (Tables 4-6) - The pre- *Paris Attacks* sample size is 1189, meaning that where 50% of a given population responded in a particular way, 19 times in 20 we can be certain that the actual value will fall 2.8% either side of the result. Fieldwork 11/11/15 to 13/11/15(2020GMT)

Pre-Paris Attacks Tables (Tables 7-9) - The post- *Paris Attacks* sample size is 339, meaning that where 50% of a given population responded in a particular way, 19 times in 20 we can be certain that the actual value will fall 5.3% either side of the result. Fieldwork 13/11/15(2020GMT) to 17/11/17.

Please note that due to the way that participants were sampled for this poll, caution should be taken when analysing the results. Fieldwork for polls of this nature are typically held over a 4-5 day period in order to ensure that participants from all communities and backgrounds can take part. Therefore, splitting the sample in this way may mean there is a significantly divergent demographic make-up of the pre and post Paris Attack waves. Though the data has subsequently been weighted to reflect the population of UK adults, some of these weights will inevitably be extreme.

Data were collected, analysed and weighted by BMG Research.
