As a research company of long-standing we are fully committed to securing information about our clients, our members of staff and the respondents we interview in accordance with the MRS Code of Conduct, Data Protection Act 2018, General Data Protection Regulation (EU) and the requirements of ISO 27001:2013. We appreciate that Information Security covers the protection of all types of information, be it electronic, on paper or spoken. To ensure our information security management system is effective we have completed a risk assessment, created a business continuity plan and developed a suitable information classification system.

We have also identified measurable objectives for the company to achieve and ensure that we adhere to legal compliance as well as conforming to regulatory standards. All members of staff receive appropriate training and are aware of their responsibilities and the consequences of not following procedures.
